Dr. Dean Maar Memorial Honoree:

Dr. Chris Pomeroy



Orthopedic Total Joint Surgeon Dr. Christopher Pomeroy received a bachelor's degree in biology and biochemistry from Indiana University in 2005. While at Indiana University, he played on two national championship soccer

teams. In 2009, he received a medical degree from University of Louisville School of Medicine in Louisville, Kentucky. He completed an orthopedic surgery residency from University of Cincinnati in Cincinnati, Ohio, in 2014 and a fellowship in total joint replacement at OrthoCarolina Hip & Knee Center in Charlotte, North Carolina, in 2015. Dr. Pomeroy is a member of the American Association of Hip and Knee Surgeons (AAHKS).

Medical Honoree:

Dr. Nigel Shaun Matthews



Dr. N. Shaun Matthews is Clinical Professor and Chair of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery & Hospital Dentistry at Indiana University School of Dentistry, as well as Associate Dean for Hospital Affairs and Director of the TMJ

Institute. He is internationally recognized for his work in temporomandibular joint surgery and well published in the field of telehealth. As a lifelong academic, he has been responsible for creating multiple, collaborative, interdisciplinary clinics embracing both dental and medical disciplines, which focus on the management of temporomandibular joint disorders in children with juvenile idiopathic arthritis. Dr. Matthews is a Fellow of both the Royal College of Surgeons of England and Edinburgh and in 2016, he was honored by the Barbados government with their Golden Jubilee Award in recognition of his service to the people of Barbados and the United Kingdom, through his work in medicine and surgery.

Ana was diagnosed with Juvenile Arthritis at age 3. Ana had just started dance classes when her mother, a nurse, noticed her toe was red and swollen. Not long after she had knee pain and swelling. With a sinking feeling of what it was, her mother contacted

her pediatrician and had X-rays and a diagnosis by the end of the day. The quick intervention of the Riley Rheumatology department had Ana back on her feet. Ana is now 13, dancing 5 days a week and an avid outdoors woman who enjoys biking, hiking, and taking pictures of sunsets! While it can still be a daily struggle dealing with joint pain, medication, lab work etc. Ana is grateful for all the research and advances in treatment for a diagnosis that could have kept her from what she loves!



Brittany Smith started volunteering for the Arthritis Foundation in 2018 as the Jingle Bell Run Corporate Chair, and then served as the Juvenile Arthritis Chair for the Indiana Leadership Board from 2019-2023. She got involved with the Arthritis

Foundation because her niece, Lilly, was diagnosed with juvenile arthritis at the age of 3. Since then, Lilly and her family have enjoyed attending, volunteering at, and fundraising for the events put on by the Arthritis Foundation.

Brittany has also organized a National Team for the Jingle Bell Run in past years at Barnes & Thornburg, where members of the various offices raised money for the event.

Adult Honoree:

Ashley Lopez



Covid set Ashley Lopez's immune system on fire, causing her body to attack itself. She went from a healthy, active person to one who was in and out of the hospital and ICU. Her colon and appendix were removed, and she was placed on disability. Living with an ostomy bag and fighting for her life taught her how to be strong and overcome. When her colon was removed, the inflammation shifted to her joints. In 2022 Ashley was diagnosed with RA and has so far had adverse reactions to the medications she has been prescribed. She often must make adjustments to do simple tasks such as opening doors and tying shoes. Ashley is determined to get back to snowboarding, rock climbing, mountain biking, and more without pain. Ashley is participating as an honoree at the Bone Bash to raise funds for new treatments and a cure to improve lives of those with arthritis.
